



Competition Officials

Canada Skateboard events operate with the following officials and staffing.

Role	Responsibility
Chief Of Competition	Competition director. Responsible for the planning and execution of the competition period. Final decisions regarding appeals, and schedule changes are Chief of Competition's to make.
Chief of Course & Timing	Responsible for the timing and execution of the competition day. Decisions regarding competition course, format are at the discretion of the Chief of Course.
Head Judge	Head judge is responsible for the scoring judges, final rankings and communications with other officials and competitors.
Scoring Judges	Responsible to score the competition runs and their final ranking.
Administrator	Responsible for the registration and building of start and heat lists.
MC / Announcer	Responsible for the sharing of technical information to all competitors and spectators. Additionally required to provide entertainment and engagement with competitors and spectators.
DJ / Music Act	Provide music and entertainment for the competitors and spectators.



Education Process:

As the evolution of the competition program continues Canada Skateboard is increasing the requirements of all officials. The following list of experience and education is required for any officials or staff operating at a Canada Skateboard Event. One person may fill multiple roles.

Role	Experience	Education
All Officials and Staff	Competition sport experience (skateboarding and other)	Safe Sport Training
Judges	High current understanding of event discipline specifics - tricks, trends, rules etc.	World Skate Judging Training or Session with Canada Skateboard technical staff
Chief of Competition	Detailed understanding of competition discipline, and competition rule book	Developing education with World Skate
Chief of Course & Timing	Detailed understanding of competition discipline, and competition rule book	Developing education with World Skate
Administrator	Expert knowledge of registration system and technical judging / event software	Registration and Boardr software session
MC / Announcer	Expert technical knowledge of event discipline, event participants, and the sport. Considerable experience hosting and announcing skateboarding or other events and competition rule book	Session with Chief of Comp to and administrator to gather information and discussion
DJ / Music Act	Experiencing performing for a skateboard or other sporting event. Knowledge of format and demographic to play appropriate music and elevate the atmosphere.	Session with Chief of Comp to and administrator to gather information and discussion
